

RULES OF THE CAMP

Pacific Primitive Rendezvous is a 1640 to 1840 primitive event. Please read and follow the rules of the camp. Rendezvous rules are in effect Friday, June 23rd at 7:00 am until Saturday, July 1st at 6:00 am.

Long term primitive camping: access by vehicle is allowed Friday, June 23rd at 7:00 a.m. until Sunday June 25th 5:00 p.m. You have a two-hour window to unload and then remove your vehicle. If you must break camp before Saturday July 1st you will have to pack it out or if there is a stock wagon, for a fee they may haul your camp, but not load it for you.

Short stay camping: All rules of primitive apply except vehicles will be allowed in camp daily from 10:00 a.m. – Noon and 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. for the sole purpose to loading and unloading camp for late arrival or early departure. There will be a limited modern tent and RV camp area. It is outside the gate, so expect a walk to reach primitive camp.

Attendance at a primitive event means that all visible clothing, lodges and accoutrements must be in the period of 1640 -1840 North America.

No modern footwear and sunglasses of any kind, unless medically required. If modern footwear is required by your doctor, please cover with period correct material. Medical documentation may be asked for so come prepared to produce if asked. Period eyewear is encouraged for those wearing glasses.

All modern items such as solar panels, coolers, cans, plastic, etc. must be kept out of sight at all times. Period fabric over drinking cans and bottles is not acceptable. Electronic gear, including phones and flashlights, must not be seen or heard. All photographic equipment must be covered when not in use. No flash photography is allowed.

Domesticated animals (dogs, cats & anything else) are allowed if on a leash or under restraint at all times. If your animal roams, bites, disturbs other, or barks a lot, be prepared to pack up your camp and you and your pet will be on the way home. All dog poop must be cleaned up, so carry a shovel and bury.

Safety and conduct of under 18 year olds are the responsibility of their parents. Direct supervision is required on the shooting, archery and hawk and knife trails. Thievery of any kind will not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from camp.

Weapons Policy- ABSOLUTELY no modern firearms or weapons will be possessed, sold or traded anywhere on Rendezvous grounds. That is including modern camp and all parking areas, by anyone, at anytime. No loaded, primed or capped firearms anywhere in camp. If you have a problem on the range, contact a Range Safety Officer or the shooting tent for assistance . DO NOT BRING IT BACK TO CAMP LOADED.

Fires must be contained in a pit and attended at all times. Have in camp at least two gallons of water and a shovel for fire control. **Please properly drown all fires at the end of the rendezvous and leave your pit UNCOVERED so the staff can water and stir again after the event.**

In an emergency, contact a dog soldier, medical officer, or staff member. Lost and found will be at the medical tent.
