



## AMM Style Primitive Camp (pack-in only)

In the American Mountain Men we strive to learn and emulate the skills used by the fur men of the Rocky Mountains, to this end our camps are different than “rendezvous” camps. The basic rule of thumb is, “if you can’t document it, you can’t have it”. They had the horse they were riding and a pack horse or two so they would have their traps and tools, a blanket or two, maybe a buff robe, tarp, a cooking pot and cup and a few misc. items for entertainment and comfort. They certainly would not have furniture, braziers, lanterns and such. Remember, What can a pack horse or two carry, so think minimalist cuz yer horse has to pack yer plews too.

We invite all to come visit or camp with us if you are of a mind to follow these guidelines, we’re not trying to be “hard core” just historically accurate.
