ICE WATER HOOTERS GARBAGE

RECYCLE FIREWOOD FOOD BANK

(Change of information below is likely, but not expected)

WATER - Water can be obtained at one of 2 water tanks. This water is potable. Period containers or an appropriate covering to transport your water back is required. NO swimming or bathing is allowed in the tanks.

FIREWOOD - There is firewood on site. Your PPR staff has been busy cutting wood the week prior to accommodate your needs. Only take what you can use. Do not cut down or in any way harm living trees. This includes your children - you are responsible for their actions.

GARBAGE: Dumpsters will be located outside the Gate - We ask that all non-recycleable containers be crushed and all garbage be put in plastic bags that are tied or somehow closed before dumping. Please do not throw away your burlap bags.

Recycle is available. A separate receptacle will be located at the gate for your recycle items. The Seneca PTA will benefit from this program. Please follow the recycle rules announced at Opening Ceremony. Do not put garbage in recycle!!

SEMINARS: Seminar schedule is posted at the Seminar Tent on Traders Row

MEMORIAL ROPE - Write the name or any remembrances on the cloth strips provided and attach them to the Memorial Rope. A memorial fire will be held at Closing Ceremony.

SHOOTERS: Event posted at Shooters Tent - Listen for meeting times at Opening Ceremony presentation

ICE -Coyote Mule Company will be delivering ice this year. Bobbie, Barney and Gentleman Jack are looking forward to another great event. Ice will be delivered throughout the camp starting Sunday thru Thursday. Possible delivery on Friday TBA. There are five "Ice Stops" located around camp. These "Ice Stops" are well marked and are the only place where ice will be sold.

Ice will only be available at these specific locations. Please wait for the team to be hitched before advancing on the wagon. Your safety is our top concern. Do not approach the team without permission from the owner or rider. Do not run at or wave things at horses or mules. Go to the back of the wagon when buying ice, not from the side.. Ask about Ice availability pre- & post delivery dates (see below)

There will not be a delivery on Friday (6/21) so be prepared. Delivery will start on Sunday. You must have a burlap/cloth bag - or another period correct something to cover the plastic bags while they are transported to your camp. Ice will not leave the ice wagon without being covered. Burlap bag will be available for purchase\$.

Prior to Opening Ceremony - Ice will be available Wed, Thur, Friday and Saturday Morning at the Refrigerator truck in the parking area for 1 hour only - between 9:00am and 10:00am **ONLY** Ice WILL NOT be delivered into camp!!! Correct change would be appreciated.

HELP IS AVAILABLE - We have several young business entrepreneurs who are willing to fetch ice and water, remove garbage and recycle for a reasonable price. Please support them if you can or you can enjoy the walk.

BEAR VALLEY STORE - This is the local store in Seneca. It's a wonderful thing to support the local economy. 541-542-9309

LOCATOR CARDS - These cards are extremely important to locate you in case of an emergency. Please be sure to fill it out in duplicate. Put one on the dash of your car and the other gets dropped off at The Registration Tent. These are housed in the Medical Tent during Rendezvous and may be the only way you can be found, especially at night.
